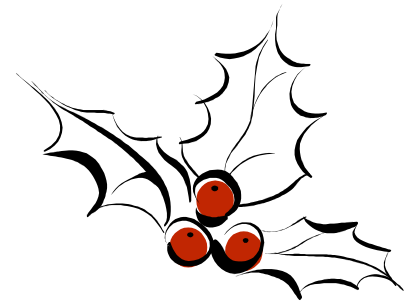




**2009 Milton-Freewater
